## **KENTUCKY STATE FAIR 4-H JOB DESCRIPTION**

### GENERAL INFORMATION

- Workers cannot be assigned to exhibit areas or activities, if they or a member of their family are completing in those areas or activities.
- A letter of recommendation from your 4-H Agent is helpful.
- You must sign in and out on a daily time sheet. There will be a supervisor on site.
- You will be paid with one check for the total amount due (all pay is taxed according to Kentucky guidelines) to you at the end of the fair.
- Daily work permits are issued to those employed to admit them to the fairgrounds on days after the fair opens. Work permits are only issued for days you actually work.
- Workers must coordinate their meal and break times with the supervisor so that the exhibit area is adequately staffed at all times.
- Workers must be 16 years old or older.
- Each worker is responsible for making own arrangements for transportation, meals, and requesting lodging if needed. (If you are not living in the Louisville area, you must tell us on your application if housing will be needed. Report to the State Fair Exhibit Area (West Hall) to pick up your key on the first day of work. **DO NOT STOP AT THE HOTEL FOR YOUR KEY. ALL KEYS ARE PICKED UP AND RETURNED TO CLOVERVILLE OFFICE.**
- Workers are not supervised after working hours.

### SET-UP - Sunday

Assist with setting up tables and chairs, covering tables with paper, hanging signs, and general set up for entries.

### ENTRIES, ASSIST JUDGES, AND SET-UP OF TOTAL EXHIBITS - Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday before St. Fair opens.

Each worker will be assigned to assist with a particular project. For the most part, they will stay with the project area-taking entries, assisting superintendents and judges, recording judges' results, putting on ribbons, and placing projects in exhibits. Two to four people will be needed for general work.

### HOST/HOESSESS -

When the fair opens on Thursday, we will have 2-3 shifts of workers each day. The first shift will work from 9:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. and/or 10:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. each day. The second shift will be from 4:00 p.m.- 10:00 p.m. These people must be comfortable meeting the public, discussing 4-H and the exhibits. In addition, they are responsible for helping to police the exhibit area and guard against damage or theft. Lots of walking and talking to the general public. General cleaning of the exhibit area is continuous. The first shift helps to clean each morning before the fair opens. The second shift cleans for one hour after the fair closes.

### ANIMAL SHOWS, TRACTOR & SMALL ENGINES CONTEST, BICYCLE RODEO, COUNTRY HAM, HORT. DOG -

If possible, people will be employed to assist the staff, superintendents and judges working with, poultry judging, tractor operators contest, bicycle rodeo, rabbit, dog shows, country ham, horticultural contest. An interest in and knowledge of these is preferred. Presenting awards at shows.

OFFICE WORKERS - ADULTS ONLY - Two people will be employed to SUPERVISE the 4-H office. They will assist the State 4-H Staff in supervising the 4-H Exhibit, and the part-time workers, answering the phone, relaying messages, keeping and sorting records, and posting results. On most days, they will be responsible for opening and closing the exhibit. They must be knowledgeable about 4-H and familiar with fair activities. Other adults will be hired to do computerized data entry. Computer people must have a working knowledge of computers.

COMMUNICATIONS - Youth will be employed to "shadow" Agriculture Communication Specialist in reporting events and activities related to 4-H. Youth who have an interest or skills in taking photographs, writing news articles, are needed. Organizing and/or introducing Speech and demonstrations will be apart of this opportunity. Youth interested should submit a one page typed summary of their interest and/or experience.
