Recipe of the month from the KLC kitchen staff:



Smoked Sausage Jambalaya

1 lb smoked sausage - sliced
1 med onion – diced
½ cup green pepper - diced
½ cup celery – diced

Sautéed items together until tender

ADD:

16 oz can diced tomatoes – Do Not Drain
4 drops of Red Hot Sauce
¼ teaspoon of black pepper

Stir together until heated
