

**UK College of Agriculture Student Council  
November Meeting Minutes**

- President Stephanie Ring called the meeting to order at 7:40pm and reminded elected members that attendance is being monitored and they can be asked to vacate their position after two unexcused absences
- Evan Conrad moved to dispense the reading of minutes, seconded by Ashley Morgan. Roll Call was then read there were 26/48 members in attendance.
- Treasurer's Report: Chanda Hall announced our account has \$400. Also, she reminded club representatives that dues are \$.50 cents a member and need to be paid ASAP.
- Evan Conrad motioned that if Clubs' Dues are not paid by next meeting (Tuesday December 10th), their voting privileges will be revoked. Matt Meyer seconded. Motion passed.

- A Report was given by Rachel Wattier-Committee Chairwoman of the Mentoring Program on their meeting this past month. - The formal committee is hoping to set up transportation to and from formal this year since it will be off-campus.

- Ashley Morgan motioned that College of Ag Formal be held February 21st at the Springs Inn pending meeting the conditions of our alcohol arrangements. The motion was seconded by Micheal Celsor. The motion passes.
