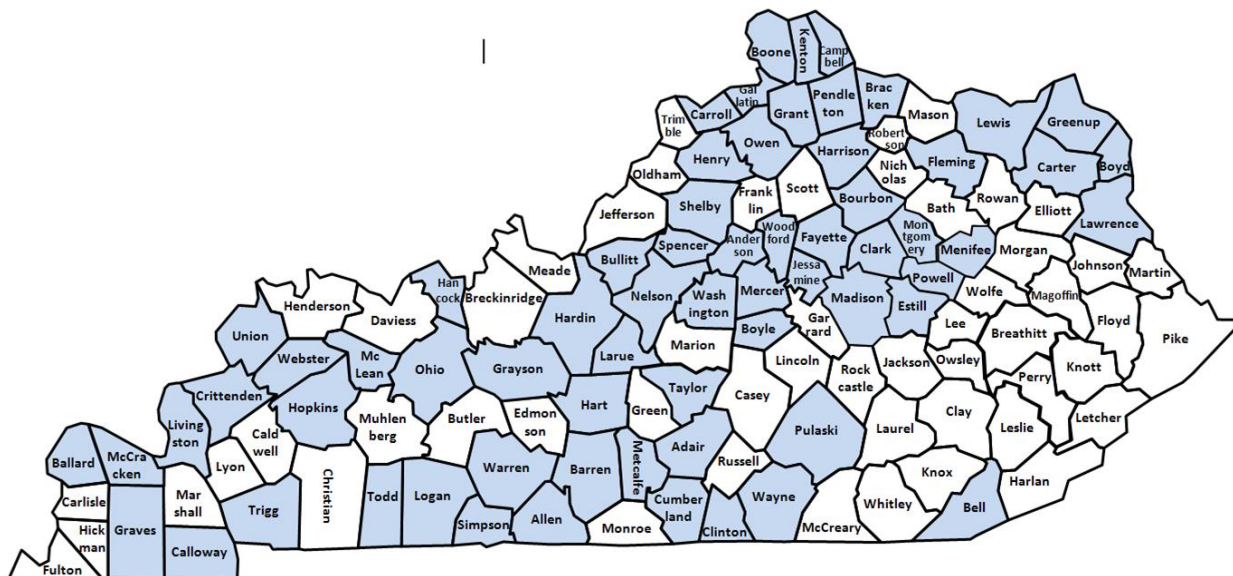


4-H Livestock Volunteer Certification



In FY08, 66 Kentucky counties participated in the 4-H Livestock Volunteer Certification program training an additional 77 volunteer leaders for the 108 4-H Livestock Clubs in these counties. This certification is required of all counties and club leaders offering the Livestock Certification curriculum.

The certification of these 77 leaders allowed an additional 2006 4-H members to complete the six hours of Certified Livestock curriculum this year.

This brings the total of certified leaders to 466 in 105 counties and includes every county in Kentucky with a 4-H Livestock Program.
