Horticulture Intern

5-10 hours a week. Responsible for continued development of LAC's teaching garden. Applicants should be self-motivated and knowledgeable of ornamental and agricultural plants. Task will include creating a garden plan, managing the health of the plants in the garden and else-where on site, procuring donations, tending the compost, observing and assisting in teaching environmental education programs and other duties as assigned.

Forestry Intern

5-10 hours a week. Responsible for working with the local forester to implement Timber Stand Improvement Practices in our 250 acre forest. Applicants should be familiar with invasive species and trained in equipment safety. Duties would include girdling trees for removal, tracking and removing invasive species, planning a forestry demonstration/volunteer service day, observing and assisting in teaching environmental education programs, and other duties as assigned.

Wildlife Management Intern

5-10 hours a week. Responsible for working with the Farm manager and local wildlife biologist and enforcement officers to maintain wildlife enhancement areas. Applicants should be self motivated and familiar with regional wildlife. Duties would include helping with managed deer and turkey hunts, planning a wildlife improvement plan, observing and assisting in teaching environmental education programs, developing wildlife habitat areas and other duties as assigned.

Environmental Education Intern

5-10 Hours a week. Responsible for assisting in the development of the LAC Environmental Education Program. Applicants should be familiar with trends in environmental education and be willing to learn the curriculum at LAC. Duties would include preparing class materials, maintain program areas, observing and assisting in teaching environmental education programs and other duties as assigned.
